

#### DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Ellis County Courthouse Historic District comprises an area of roughly 25 square blocks in the center of downtown Waxahachie, Texas. Located within this area are some fifty architecturally or historically significant buildings and engineering structures. Dating from the late nineteenth through the early twentieth century, these structures reflect the history of Waxahachie during its prominence as a major cotton producing region in the Southwest. Primarily commercial in character, the district centers around the Ellis County Courthouse in the public square.

The historic district is defined roughly by the area between Waxahachie Branch Creek on the North, Waxahachie Creek on the South, Elm Street on the West, and Flat Street on the East. The Ellis County Courthouse (1) dominates the central business district. Designed by the famous Texas architect J. Reilly Gordon in 1895, the building is rich in Romanesque detail. A central tower forms the stairwell around which the various county offices radiate from four levels. Originally open from the basement to the top of the bell tower, the stairwell has unfortunately been converted to an elevator shaft. Interior detailing is rich with Romanesque filigree patterns in plaster comprising the wainscoting in hallways, offices, and courtrooms. The axial plan in the form of a Greek cross is complicated with projecting bays and turrets. Entrances are located in the four corners formed by the projections of the cross from the central tower.

Exterior surface treatment of pink granite with rock-faced texture is combined with red sandstone window lintel and sill bands to enhance the massive quality of the building. Windows are typically Romanesque in detail with rounded arches and slender proportions. An extensive gray slate roof of steep pitch follows the various undulations around the exterior walls. Turrets with conical roofs and dormers with chimney extensions project from the roof in random fashion. The massive clock tower with projecting bartizans and a pyramidal roof can be seen from miles around.

Surrounding the courthouse on four sides are numerous late nineteenth and early twentieth century buildings. On the Northwest corner of the square at 200 West Main is the Waxahachie Abstract Company building (3). Built ca. 1895 in the commercial Romanesque style, surface treatment combines cut sandstone of rock-faced texture on the street level with

red brick on the two upper levels. Window reveals indicate a 24-inch wall thickness with sandstone transom mullions. Cornice projections on the corners protrude from the flat roof. Original interior detailing and ornamentation, by contrast, is Neo-Classical in style.

Adjoining the Abstract Company at 210 and 208 West Main (2) are two Victorian commercial buildings built ca. 1890. Two stories in height, original cast iron storefronts and elaborate tin cornices are their finest features. To the North of the Abstract Company at 105, 107, and 109 North Rogers are three Victorian commercial buildings. Typical red brick construction is supported by cast iron storefronts on their East facades. Directly across Rogers Street from these buildings are two similar one-story Victorian commercial structures (5). Recently renovated in an effort to stimulate interest in the central business district, the buildings display attractive canvas awnings and color schemes.

The Northern end of the historic district is defined by Waxahachie Branch Creek. Recent landscaping along the creek between North Rogers and North College Streets has created a charming urban space (40). Overlooking the landscaped area is the second Ellis County Jail building (6), located on the Northeast corner of North Rogers and Water Streets. Built circa 1885, the building is Chateauesque in style. Red brick walls are pierced in irregular fashion by tall, narrow windows. A round turret with conical roof dominates the two-story structure. The walls of the octagonal cell chamber are still extant, although the interior mechanism has been removed. Several other Victorian commercial structures, with cast iron storefronts are located along North College Street across from the jail (7, 8, 9).

The Rogers Hotel building dominates the Northeast corner of the courthouse square (10). Built in 1912 of dark brown brick, the hotel consists of twin four-story towers with an open well between. A roof garden provided the hotel guests with a panoramic view of the town for many years. An even balance between the large windows and the spandrels between floors conveys the structural steel framing system and the Commercial Style influence on its design.

Around the square are many late nineteenth and early twentieth century buildings (11,12,13,14,16,17,19). The first Penn Building, 1894, (12) is an excellent example of the Romanesque Commercial Style with rounded arches, stone quoins, and a corbel table. Another Penn Building was built in 1912 (19), indicating the progression of architectural styles from the Romanesque to the Commercial Style. An interesting example of the Neo-Classical Revival style can be found in the First National Bank building (14), circa 1910. Restrained in form and surface ornamentation, the flat surfaced walls are built of white sandstone. Large rounded arched openings allude to the depth of the door and window reveals. Across the street on the Southwest corner of Franklin and Rogers Street is the finest example of the Romanesque Commercial Style on the square (16). Built circa 1898, the building is dominated by a square tower with pyramidal roof on the Northeast corner. facade is symmetrical with seven bays in an "ABCACBA" pattern. Composite pilasters in low relief divide each bay of the facade.

Only a few intrusions are found around the square. The Waxahachie Bank and Trust Company building located on the Southeast corner of Franklin at Rogers Streets (17) is probably the most offensive. The other three buildings that share the South side of the square are rather unpretentious late nineteenth and early twentieth century commercial structures. However, the most elaborate example of the High Victorian Italianate Style in the district is the Masonic Building on the Southeast corner of Franklin at College Streets (18). Built in 1889 as an office-commercial structure in conjunction with the Masonic Temple, the building displays typical tall and narrow windows with stilted segmental and rounded arches. Brick pilasters flank either side of the double windows on the West facade. A profusion of decorative Victorian motifs embellish the tin cornice that caps the composition.

The streets behind the courthouse square to the East and South display many variations of the late nineteenth century one-story, cast iron storefront commercial building (20,22,23,25,26). Similarly, the streets Southwest of the square include examples of the early twentieth century equivalent of the nineteenth century cast iron storefront building: the large plate glass windowed storefront between brick columns (27,28,29,31,32). Located in the midst of all the commercial buildings is a law office

in the Greek Revival style, circa 1875 (21), the third Ellis County Jail in the Mission Style, 1920 (24), and an original service station, circa 1915 (30).

The Southern end of the district is dominated by seven structures which have played an important part in the daily life of Waxahachie. The Federal Building (33) located on the Southeast corner of Madison and South Rogers Streets is the finest public building in the Neo-Classical Revival Style in the city. Designed by the General Services Administration in the current style of the day, the building was completed in 1914. Restrained in detail with no extraneous surface ornamentation, the building exemplifies the primary principles of the Neo-Classical Style: heavy columns of the Greek order, linteled door and window openings, pilasters in low relief, simple entablature, and low-pitched hipped roof. The original bronze lamp posts with simple spherical globes flank either side of the entrance steps. The only exterior alterations were the replacement of the original front doors with those of extruded aluminum, and the enclosing of the large mail room windows on the East facade when the interior was remodeled for office space after the Post Office moved in 1967.

One block south of the Federal Building are the Rock Island and Katy Railroad Stations (35 and 36). The Chicago, Rock Island and Pacific Railroad Depot (35), circa 1900, is typical of the stations built at the turn of the century. The walls are of yellow brick while the door and window quoins and wainscoting are of contrasting red brick. An octagonal telegrapher's turret dominates the building. Two stories in height, the tower is capped by a crenelated parapet wall. An extensive red tiled roof with wide eaves terminates the composition. A similar red tiled roof caps the Missouri-Kansas-Texas Railway Depot (36) hinsame the same area. Much simpler in overall form than the Rock Island Depot, the Katy Depot, circa 1895, is also built of yellow brick with red brick wainscoting. A square telegrapher's bay protrudes through the roof in the form of a dormer window.

Perhaps the most unique engineering feature in the district is the Rogers Street Bridge that crosses Waxahachie Creek (37). Manufactured by the Wrought Iron Bridge Company in Canton, Ohio, the structure was shipped

by rail to Waxahachie and assembled in 1889. Approximately 100 feet in length, the structural system would be classed as a three span covered truss bridge with wooden flooring. One block to the West of the wrought iron bridge is the Elm Street viaduct, circa 1918, spanning the valley along Waxahachie Creek (38). A structural system of reinforced concrete piers and beams support the span of 1000 feet. A heavy concrete balustrade forms the only railing along which simple lamp posts were originally spaced at intervals of 30 feet. Almost immediately below the viaduct on the South side of the creek is the Paymaster Oil Mill Company (39). Built before the turn of the century when the cotton industry was at its peak, the mill is constructed of red brick. A decline in cotton production in Ellis County in the last few years has contributed greatly to the lack of maintenance at the mill.

#### STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Within the twenty-five square blocks around the Ellis County Courthouse square in the central business district of Washachie, Texas, are located over fifty buildings and engineering structures representing the booming economy of the cotton industry during the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. Known at one time as the "Queen City of the Cotton Belt," Waxahachie enjoyed the finest amenities the bustling economy could provide for many years. Because of its good fortune during the time when labor and materials were cheap and its location in a semi-rural area, the town has been able to retain an early twentieth century quality both in appearance and life-style.

The beginning of the town of Waxahachie dates from 1839 when E. W. Rogers received a grant from the Republic of Texas for 640 acres. Ellis County was an open prairie at that time with Indians and buffalo in abundance. The Rogers family built a homestead on the property in 1847 where the town now stands. Two years later in 1849 the village of Waxahachie was chartered and named from an Indian word. The Shawnee Trail, the principal route out of Texas used by cattle drivers seeking northern markets before the Civil War, passed through the center of present day Waxahachie on its route between San Antonio and the Red River. The fertile soil and climate of the prairie was found to be ideal for raising cotton in the period after the Civil War. With the arrival of the Texas and New Orleans Railroad in the Late 1870's, Waxahachie had become quite a prosperous commercial center. The Texas and New Orleans Railroad (later acquired by the Southern Pacific) was soon followed by the Chicago, Rock Island and Pacific and the Missouri-Kansas-Texas Railroads due to the increasing cotton production.

The present courthouse in the town square was preceded by three other structures on the same site (1). Designed by the famous San Antonio architect J. Reilly Gordon, the original construction contract was let to Otto P. Kroeger of San Antonio on November 3, 1894. The dedication

was held July 4, 1895 and the pink granite structure has had only minor alterations to its Richardsonian Romanesque facades in the 80 years it has dominated the town square.

Around the courthouse on the four sides of the town square are located many examples of the architectural styles that were popular during the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. Among these styles are Romanesque Commercial, Victorian Commercial, High Victorian Italianate, Neo-Classical Revival and Early Twentieth Century Commercial. Most outstanding of these buildings is the Masonic Building (18) built in 1889 in the High Victorian Italianate style. Essentially unaltered from its original plan with only minor exterior deviations, the structure has been the focal point of major Masonic functions for many years. The property has recently been acquired by the Ellis County Historical Museum and Art Gallery for use as the headquarters for their annual "Gingerbread Trail" pilgrimage.

Another outstanding historical property on the town square is the Rogers Hotel building. Constructed on the site of the original 1847 Rogers Homestead in 1912, the building had been the center of Waxahachie social life before its decline as a hotel enterprise in the 1960's. It originally housed the town's first swimming pool, and the roof garden offered a panoramic view of the town. The Interurban Railway between Dallas and Waco stopped at the entrance on College Street. A ticket office occupied one of the original spaces off the first floor lobby. However, the interurban line was removed in 1940. The building was closed in 1964 after Interstate Highway 35 opened between Dallas and Waco and claimed the declining hotel business. The City of Waxahachie has recently purchased the property from the C. A. Wilson Company and will convert it into a retirement home with funds received from an HUD grant.

The outlying blocks around the square contain other significant examples of late nineteenth and early twentieth century architectural styles. The second Ellis County Jail building (6) is an excellent example of the Chateauesque styled confinement institution. Unfortunately, the rotating

octagonal cell mechanism was used for scrap metal during World War II. However, the original exterior walls are intact. Another interesting example of early twentieth century public architecture is the Federal Building (33). Built in 1914 of white sandstone to house both the U. S. Post Office and other Federal offices, the building is an excellent example of the Neo-Classical style designed by the General Services Administration. The U. S. Postal Service vacated the structure for a new building in 1967. The City of Waxahachie purchased the building in 1974 for adaptation into city offices. The lowered ceilings will be removed to reveal the original two-storied coffered ceilings.

A picturesque quality exists in the area along Waxahachie Creek. Both the Rock Island and Katy Railway depots (35 and 36) can be seen to the East from the 1918 Elm Street viaduct (38). Located a few feet from the Katy depot on South Rogers Street is the first wrought iron bridge over Waxahachie Creek (37). Built by the Wrought Iron Bridge Company of Canton, Ohio, the structure was shipped by rail to Waxahachie in 1889. The bridge is carefully maintained and is in daily service. To the west of the viaduct on the south side of the creek is the Paymaster Oil Mill Company. Among the first cottonseed oil mills in Ellis County, the plant has seen daily service since the late 1880's.

E. Main Street. From here it continues for two city blocks to the center of Kaufman Street at which point it continues south to the center of north Main Street. It follows the center of the street westerly to the center line of the intersection with Flat Street and continues south along Flat Street to the center of the alley behind the buildings facing north on Franklin Street. From this point it continues westerly to the center of Jackson Street, continues south along Jackson Street to the intersection with Jefferson Street, and then continues west along Jefferson Street to the intersection of College Street. From here it continues south for two blocks to the Rock Island Railroad property where it encircles the Rock Island Freight Station on the east side of College Street. From here it continues south to the south bank of Waxahachie Creek. From this point it continues in a straight line for three city blocks until it reaches the outer western edge of the Paymaster Oil Mill Company property. From this point the boundary line projects north to the north bank of Waxahachie Creek, then continues in a straight line easterly to the centerline of the S. Elm Street viaduct. From here it continues northerly for approximately 1000 feet to the north end of the viaduct, at which point it follows a straight line easterly to the center of the block between Elm and Rogers Streets. Then it continues north to the centerline of W. Jefferson Street, where it continues westerly to the center of S. Elm Street. From here it continues one block to the center of W. Franklin Street and continues east for half a block to the center of the alley behind the buildings facing east onto the courthouse square. It continues north through the alley until it intersects W. Main Street where it heads west down Main Street to the center of Elm Street. From here it continues north for half a block to the alley behind the present City Hall. it continues east again around the City Hall to the center of N. Rogers Street where it continues north to the beginning point of the boundary.


